A study on problems faced by anganwadi workers and suggestions given by them

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SUMMARY : To analyse the socio- personal characteristics and to list out the problems faced by Anganwadi workers and suggestions given by the Anganwadi workers, a study was conducted with random sampling. The functioning of Anganwadi workers was assessed by interviewing for their literacy status, years of experience, problems and suggestions. Results revealed that most of the Anganwadi workers were middle aged (60.92%), high school level of education (46.36%), 73.63 per cent were married, 33.63 per cent of the total sample were with less than five years experience and between five to ten years. Most of the Anganwadi workers complained that they had no time to conduct pre-school education (89.45%), and 78 per cent suggested to fix the timings for pre-school activities.

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
