

Behavioural problems of students faced by school administration in Punjab

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■ **ABSTRACT** : Private schools faced lesser behavioural problems of students than Govt. school, the students are more disciplined in private school and each child is made to follow proper discipline. However, Govt. school teachers do not focus on discipline and are more concerned about their teaching job and do not concentrate on social and overall development of children. Discipline in these schools is not generally paid attention and students generally lack disciplined behaviour which is never taught to them. The student was conducted in both private and Govt. schools and the results revealed that behaviour problems were faced by the Govt. school teachers were more than the private school teachers.
