A study on the self-concept of the adolescent girls from rural and urban areas

A sum of 200 adolescents girls from six different colleges from Muzaffarnagar district ranging in age from 13-19 years were served as sample out of which 100 adolescent girls from urban area and 100 adolescent girls from rural areas were included to the sample. Self-concept to the respondents was assured through self-concept rating scale developed by Saraswat. There was found to be significant difference between the respondents from rural and urban areas at self-concept. The adolescent girls from rural areas had high self-concept.
