ABSTRACT : The present investigation on the study on herbaceous perennials of Kashmir valley for landscape use were conducted in three districts of Kashmir valley .For this purpose four representative sites were selected and observations on prominent characteristic viz., type of inflorescence, flower size, flower shape, fragrance, flower colour as per (RHS colour chart) foliage colour, foliage texture and landscape use were recorded by making exploratory trips to these sites. The study revealed a large number of ornamental bulbous plants growing satisfactorily in this environment and producing a majestic display in gardens from early spring until late fall.
