The variables education, innovativeness, occupation and 11.07.2016; source of information showed positive and significant relationship at 0.05 level of probability. The Accepted : characteristics like social participation and cosmopoliteness showed positive and non-significant 21.07.2016 relationship with reading behaviour. Not getting proper information about agriculture, employment in complete form, advertisement print more in number, non- availability of newspaper in time, quality of printing is not good were the major constraints faced by the respondents.
