SUMMARY : The Krishi community radio acts as a medium for providing a voice to the voiceless of the farming community and play vital role for development, communication, governance, decision making, participation and health through designed programmes. Community radio caters the need of farming community. The present research study was conducted in Chikbyalikatti and Mangalakatti village revealed that, the agriculture programme *viz*., Varadabasanna, Krishi chintana, Avishkaragalu were the more prefered by the listeners.
