

## **HAS(Hind Agri-Horticultural Society)**

### **Peer Review & Plagiarism Policy:**

We are committed to prompt evaluation and publication of fully accepted papers in all HAS Scientific journals. To maintain a high-quality publication, all submissions undergo a rigorous review process. Characteristics of the peer review process are as follows:

- Submitted manuscripts should be the original works of the author(s). Using thoughts or work of other authors without authorization and the representation of that author's work as one's own is not accepted and considered as a serious non ethical academic issue.
- In all conditions, authors are advised to check for plagiarism using a known standard program before sending final corrected articles to avoid rejection when checked later on by HAS (Hind Agri-Horticultural Society) for detection of potential plagiarism.
- All manuscripts submitted will be checked for plagiarism (copying text or results from other sources) and self-plagiarism (duplicating substantial parts of authors' own published work without giving the appropriate references) using the Online database. Plagiarism is not tolerated.
- Fabrication, manipulation or falsification of data is strongly unacceptable and insert authors in the black list.
- Simultaneous submissions of the same manuscript to different journals will not be tolerated.
- Authors must ensure that they have typed entirely original participations and if an author has used the work and/or words of others, it is necessary to indicate the source of the information within his paper using an internal citation.
- Depending on individual journal policy, submissions usually will be refereed by 2 experts as suggested by the editorial board.
- In addition, Editors will have the option of seeking additional reviews when needed. Authors will be informed when Editors decide further review is required.
- All publication decisions are made by the journal's Editors-in-Chief on the basis of the referees' reports. Authors of papers that are not accepted are notified promptly.
- All submitted manuscripts are treated as confidential documents. We expect our Board of Reviewing Editors and reviewers to treat manuscripts as confidential material as well.
- Editors and reviewers involved in the review process should disclose conflicts of interest resulting from direct competitive, collaborative, or other relationships with any of the authors, and remove oneself from cases in which such conflicts preclude an objective evaluation. Privileged information or ideas that are obtained through peer review must not be used for competitive gain.
- Our peer review process is confidential and identities of reviewers cannot be revealed.
- HAS (Hind Agri-Horticultural Society) Journals require all authors to follow the international ethical standards as prescribed by the Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE).
